T. Singleton reported attending the May 5th clean up in Wilshire.

c. Bylaws Committee:

Bylaws committee reported on their discussions. They immediately focused on the incoming Board Members, and setting an ideal number of board members. Including attendance in the Bylaws was covered, with T. Singleton noting that there are some Board members who are not able to attend, but still make a contribution to this organization
Bylaws committee asked that C. Bates determine that if we update these Bylaws, if City approval is necessary.

d. Recruitment and Membership:

T. Singleton noted that he wanted to ensure that any new KSB board members were engaged and felt welcome. H. Mobley Anderegg noted that she could do some legwork to see if there was a space for us to meet in a more informal setting.

Carliss noted that with this project, tonnage is the goal. We are looking for the big amount to gauge our success.

Sign-ups were discussed. The process of creating a “neighborhood,” noting that someone does have to be in charge of an organized neighborhood to fully participate in some of the City’s activities. We do not have the infrastructure to organize, promote, and actually manage an event.

g. Cigarette Litter Prevention

3 month program to install ash tray programs, on River Street in our area. Discussion regarding efficacy of these programs, with H. The Savannah Waterfront Association, River Street Restaurant Groups, and Live Oak Restaurant Group were identified as prime partnerships for our Litter Program.
