How to get started

Step 1: Build a Team



The Adopt-A-Spot programs can accommodate an array of volunteer interests and goals:

- * Businesses
- * Neighborhood associations
- * Families
- * Community and civic organizations
- * Church groups
- * School groups or clubs

Step 2: Choose a Location



An Adopt-A-Spot project can include many different types of activities. Sites can range from the street in front of your house, to the nearest park, to the major thoroughfares of our city. It may be as simple as picking up stray litter in your local park once a month, or it may be a longer-term project such as weeding, planting, and maintaining a specific area.

Step 3: Complete the Agreement

Once your spot has been selected and approved, then complete the Adopt-A-Spot Agreement which states your commitment for the Adopt-A-Spot program.

Step 4: Set a Date



Make a plan and set a date for your first cleanup!

Step 5: Request Supplies from Keep Savannah Beautiful

Keep Savannah Beautiful will provide a limited amount of cleaning supplies (bags, gloves, and grabbers) and coordinate the pickup of our trash bags by Sanitation after your cleanup.
