## CAN YOU RECYCLE IT?

- Hard plastic #1-7
  - Glass
  - Aluminum, tin or steel cans
  - Paper, newspaper, magazines, junk mail
  - Cardboard containers that hold liquids, such as milk & juice
  - Dry cardboard
- YES** YOU CAN RECYCLE IT!
- Plastic bags
  - Paint cans
  - Clothing, bedding
  - Toys, electronics
  - Styrofoam containers or packaging
  - Furniture, plastic chairs
  - Yard waste or clippings
  - Aluminum foil
- NO** YOU CANNOT RECYCLE IT!

## YARD WASTE

- #1 **BROWN BAG IT:** Place leaves, grass or sticks in brown biodegradable paper bags (15 bag limit) or containers (not City-issued carts) no more than 32 gallons in size.
- #2 **CAN IT:** Maximum container size is 32 gallons. Do not use garbage or recycling carts.
- #3 **STACK IT:** Yard waste bundles must be less than 4 feet in length, 12 inches or less in diameter, weigh 40 pounds or less and take no more than 5 minutes to remove.

## BULK ITEMS

- Bulk items are collected weekly on the resident's trash collection day. You are not required to schedule this service.
- Bulk items taking less than 5 minutes to service will be collected at no charge.
- Bulk items taking more than 5 minutes will be charged a fee per the City of Savannah Revenue Ordinance.
- Place bulk items at the regular point of collection with the Sanitation Department's refuse (green) carts on your scheduled collection day

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Trash & Recycling carts should have a minimum of 3 feet separation from each other at curbside and should be at least 3 feet from mail boxes and other obstructions.

Carts should be placed at point of collection by 7 a.m.
