



## **Key highlights of Feb. 27 Council meeting:**

- **Presentations**
  - Council recognized three youth football teams from Savannah who won the 2019 Georgia Recreation and Parks Association State Championship in their divisions
  - Council recognized the Savannah Multiple Sclerosis Community Council and designated March as Multiple Sclerosis awareness month
  - Council recognized the Georgia Research Environmental Economic Network, Inc. (GREEN) with a proclamation to honor the organization's 31<sup>st</sup> anniversary
- **Purchasing Items**
  - Delayed a decision on the continuation or termination of a contract with Downtowner for late night on-demand ridership for downtown workers pending further discussion of other options.
  - Council renewed the \$148,837.50 annual license and maintenance agreement with ShotSpotter, Inc.
  - Approved a contract modification for construction of City facilities at Interchange Court. Modification was needed to remove unsuitable soil and bring in suitable structural fill dirt, among other things.
  - Approved a \$2.2 million annual contract for street resurfacing and repair

  - Approved transferring titles for 10 properties in West and East Savannah to the Land Bank Authority for development into single-family homes for moderate-income residents.
