



At-Home Craft: 3D Greeting Card



Supplies Needed Colored Paper Scissors
Glue Stick Markers or Colored Pencils


If you don't have colored paper, use a marker, paint, or pencil to color your shapes later




1 Fold a piece of colored paper, lengthwise.



2 Draw half of a heart along the folded edge and cut along that line, making a full heart cutout.



3 Use this stencil to trace 3 more hearts and cut them out. You now have 4 hearts.



4 Glue half of the back of one heart to the back of another. Continue gluing the backs of the hearts together, half a heart at a time.



5 Fold a full piece of paper in half to make the card. Glue the hearts to the front of your card.



6 Use pencils or markers to turn your shape into a fun card, making a flower, hot air balloon, beach umbrella - whatever you like! Don't forget to sign your card!
