


# At-Home Craft: Tissue Paper Watercolor


**Supplies Needed:** Tissue Paper      Paper (watercolor or regular printer paper)  
Water      Spray bottle or sponge  
Optional: Scissors (to cut tissue paper), heavy book (to flatten final project)




1 Wet paper with a spray bottle or sponge. Paper should be visibly wet without creating a puddle.




2 Place tissue paper on the wet paper, creating any abstract design of your choice. Tissue paper can be torn or cut with scissors.




3 Wet the final design.



4 Allow the tissue to dry completely. This could take an hour or two.



5 Once the tissue is dry, slowly peel it off the paper to reveal your design! The paper will have a light watercolor stain that can be embellished with a drawing or used for another craft, like origami or a card!



6 Other notes: This project works best with bold colored tissue. Crunching the tissue paper before laying down can create a textured look.
