Artist Adventures	<p><u>Provided by Student:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Glue</li> <li>Scissors</li> <li>Tape</li> <li>Construction Paper</li> <li>Crayons</li> <li>Pipe Cleaner</li> <li>Acrylic Paint, Watercolor Paint, Paint brush</li> <li>Cardboard (at least two 7x11" sheets)</li> <li>Tissue Paper</li> <li>Yarn</li> <li>Recycled Newspapers and/or magazine</li> </ul> <p>Optional: Color Pencils, Markers *some activities will require a bowl or cup of water</p>
Art Journaling for Teens	<p><u>Provided by Student:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Journal or Notebook with pages thick enough to handle paint</li> <li>Acrylic or Gouache Paint</li> <li>Paint Brushes</li> <li>Packing Tape (Clear)</li> <li>Drawing pencils – Examples: Graphite, Color</li> <li>Collage Materials – Examples: Newspaper, Magazines, Photographs, Tissue Paper, Found or Scrap Paper, Junk Mail, Wallpaper Samples, Books, Memorabilia (tickets, postcards etc.)</li> </ul>
