



Summary of Major Findings

Housing Savannah Task Force research uncovered several important findings that help describe Savannah's housing affordability challenge.

1. Housing costs in Savannah have outpaced incomes by at least 2:1 over the past 30 years.
2. This has led, in part, to about 21,000 (40%) Savannah households having a difficult time affording quality housing.
3. Broken down further, this means that many households with annual income less than \$50,000 or individuals with annual incomes less than \$35,000 are likely to have a difficult time affording quality housing.
4. These conditions negatively impact not only those in need of housing, but also the community and the economy as a whole.
