



HEATH LLOYD is an experienced executive with nearly 15 years of local government experience and master's degrees in public administration, business administration and civil engineering. He is also a registered professional engineer in the state of Georgia. Heath serves the City of Savannah as the Chief Infrastructure and Development Officer, a second-in-command position, and Assistant City Manager, assuming these roles nearly four years ago. As the Assistant City Manager, he is responsible for implementation of nearly \$170 million of the City of Savannah's budget while also being responsible for the supervision of 675 full-time employees. He and his team have succeeded in dramatically improving the City of Savannah's ability to implement SPLOST projects, developed and implemented a city-wide street repair and maintenance system, and managed the construction of a state-of-the-art emergency preparedness facility. Heath also worked with his team on revitalizing the City of Savannah's downtown, expanding the City's municipal boundaries via annexation, improving its parks and community centers, and engaged in continued customer service improvements in the Development Services Department. Heath and his team manage the long-term planning and daily operation of the City of Savannah's public works functions, to include improvements to the City's drainage system, sanitary sewer system and expansion of the city's water supply

capacity. He led teams to execute, on-time and within budget, the City's \$190 million from 2017-2021 capital budget for infrastructure improvements, and he was instrumental in advocating for a \$24 million commitment to street maintenance in SPLOST VII—the largest ever. Heath has overseen the City's first major overhaul of the comprehensive land use and zoning ordinance, known as NEWZO. Heath has held various leadership positions with the City of Savannah, specifically the Interim Revenue Director, Public Works Operations Director, and Water Supply and Treatment Director.

Heath's significant local government experience has shaped him into an innovative and forward-focused leader with a track record of implementing projects, building partnerships and promoting collaboration, while accomplishing goals by working across the organization and dealing with competing priorities. Heath has a history of refreshing and refocusing governmental functions while making the government more transparent, flexible, customer and business friendly. During his career, Heath has earned trust, respect and recognition from elected officials, media, citizens, developers, business groups and employees.

Heath, along with his wife of 17 years and their two sons, have enjoyed the Coastal Empire region for nearly two decades.
