New Improvements for 1885 - Krouskoff - section 10 - 2 three-story houses.

From the above it seems that houses were erected on these tow lots in both 1882 and 1884. Which is which is impossible to tell.

Sanborn's map of 1888 shows two very similar pairs of houses on these two lots. Sanborn's map of 1898 shows a double house on lot 1 and a single house on lot 2. Obviously something happened to the double house on lot 2. On April 7, 1889 the fire records show a fire at the location of the houses on lot 2. Therefore it owuld seem that either the double house was completely destroyed and a single one built to take its place, or only the southern half was destroyed and the single house shown on the 1898 map represents the remaining half. That single house was remodeled ca 1914 by the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

804-806 was built for S. Krouskoff in ~~either 1882 or 1884~~.

808 Drayton was built in ~~either 1882 or 1884~~, or possibly in 1899-90



Therefore 107 probably is the first house built in 1875 and was remodelde in 1907. However this is not conclusive. Perhaps a study of the construction could tell.
