Scope and Content:

Record Series 2152-002, Traffic Engineering Plans and Designs include as-builts, aerial overlays, sketch plans, studies, and concept designs for streets in and around Savannah, Georgia. The content of these plans and designs includes Savannah streets and state highways, with alterations or additions to exit highway ramps, widening of streets, and changes to medians and sidewalks. Other plans detail the alterations or installation of traffic signals, street signage, parking layouts, utilities, and lighting. The plans and designs come from the Georgia Department of Transportation, Chatham County Engineering Department, and City of Savannah Engineering Department. Most of these projects were in collaboration with municipalities and companies. The plans and designs were produced by private engineering companies commissioned by the City of Savannah or produced by City of Savannah engineers.

The plans and designs are dated from 1944 to 2020. Included are hand drawn plans and designs, and mass-produced plans, some with over hundreds of sheets. Other plans have attached documents and handwritten annotations or edits to them. Items of significance include the Savannah Lot and Block Atlas book from 1949 and the lighting layout and blueprints for Grayson Stadium showing the segregated sections (this is also the oldest dated plan in this collection).
