Biographical History:

Augusta Oelschig was born on June 12, 1918, in Savannah, Georgia. She attended school in Savannah's public school system and was a member of the first graduating class at Armstrong Junior College in 1935. In 1937, she transferred to the University of Georgia where she received a B.F.A degree and then pursued post-graduate studies at Auburn University, Mexico City College, and the New School for Social Research. Her teachers include Emma Wilkins, Lamar Dodd, Justino Fernandez, and Diego Rivera. Oelschig lived in New York from 1948 through 1962 and she then returned to Savannah where she was an active member of the Savannah Art Association. Her art often explored African American life in the Low Country, sometimes depicting issues of violent social injustices suffered by African Americans. Augusta Oelschig retired in 1976 and died on July 24, 2000. Oelshig's art is now held in private collections as well as many art museums, including the Telfair Museums and Georgia Historical Society in Savannah, The Morris Museum of Art in Augusta, Georgia, and The Johnson Collection in Spartanburg, South Carolina.

Scope & Content:

The Augusta Oelschig art collection consists of more than 70 sketches executed by Augusta Oelschig, two sketches from artist Christopher Murphy Jr., one sketch by Alan Morris Kuzmicki, and a woodcut from an unknown Japanese artist, all of which are stored inside the portfolio case they were received in. The sketches are executed in pencil, gouache, and ink on paper or tracing paper. The subjects include wildlife, farm animals such as roosters, buildings, sketches of unidentified people, buildings and domestic scenes, scenes inspired by traditional Mexican art, illustrations for manuscripts, and studies for named completed works. The collection also includes two *Savannah Morning News* clippings and one clipping from the *New York Times*.

The Augusta Oelschig collection is arranged in the order that it was received with a numbering system and cataloging notes as assigned by the Telfair Museums.
