Influenza (“flu”) is a contagious disease that spreads around the United States every year, usually between October and May. Flu viruses are spread mainly by coughing, sneezing, and close contact. Each year **thousands of people in the United States die from flu**, and many more are hospitalized. Flu strikes suddenly and can last several days.

Symptoms vary by age, but can include:

- Fever or chills
- Sore Throat
- muscle or body aches
- Fatigue (tiredness)
- Cough
- Headaches
- Runny or Stuffy Nose

The Flu vaccine can:

- Keep you from getting the flu
- Make flu less severe if you do get it
- Keep you from spreading flu to your family and others

Protect yourself and family, stop by and get your flu vaccine!

All City employees/dependents on the City Health plan can also get a flu vaccination at any pharmacy providing vaccinations by showing their medical card.

****Please note flu vaccinations are not covered via the Minute Clinic. They are only covered if given at the pharmacy with your City of Savannah Health Insurance card. *****
