I understand that if there is a proven cemetery lot owner or owners of the referenced lot other than specified that I, as a claimant, may be required to restore the cemetery lot at my own expense to its condition prior to my claim. The restoration may include the legal disinterment and re-interment of any remains that I wrongfully authorized to be interred on the said lot. I also understand that I may be subject to prosecution for making a false claim of cemetery lot ownership. Should any person bring a claim or lawsuit against the City of Savannah arising out of or in any way related to this Claim, I specifically agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Savannah in connection with any such claim or lawsuit, which shall include all costs and legal fees.
