The City of Savannah Honors and Awards collection contains awards, certificates, and trophies that were awarded to City of Savannah employees, Mayors, and departments from nonprofit, federal, military institutions, and other City departments. These awards were for successful programs established by the City, valuable contributions to the community, achievements that went above and beyond government responsibilities, leadership, and employee success. The awards come in various formats, including wooden plaques, small trophies, paper certificates, framed certificates, and medals. An award of note is the Certificate of Appreciation awarded to the City of Savannah's Water and Sewer Bureau for support during the response and recovery at the Imperial Sugar Refinery dust explosion, in which thirteen lives were lost on February 7, 2008.
