



How to Use the Building Permit Map




Permit Clusters

Each numbered circle on the map represents a group, or cluster, of permits in that area. As you zoom into the map, you'll notice the large clusters will break into smaller clusters of permits within a more specific area. You can click on any cluster to open an informational pop-up window for the permits in that cluster. A small arrow in the top right corner of the informational pop-up allows you to click through the permits within the same pop-up window. You can continue zooming in to reach location dots for individual permit entries.



Address Locator Bar

Use the address locator at the top left of the map screen to zoom to a specific location. Use search by applicant name from the drop down to find permit location.




Info Summary

Click on the Info Summary icon to open a window providing information on all the permits currently displayed on the map. Permits are sorted into the two major types, Commercial or Residential. Within each type, permits are further sorted by status (Approved, In Review, Issued). To the right of these categories, you can see the number of permits within the two major types and the three status options. By clicking the arrow icon to the right of each status category you can see a list of the individual permits with the category. Clicking on an entry in this list will bring up its specific permit details.



Layer List

To see the map's options for displaying different layers of information, click the icon for the Layer List widget. In the Layer List window, you can turn on and off layers of data to change what information is displayed on the map. We recommend zooming in to the location you wish to explore before turning on extra layers. This will allow layers to load data at a quicker rate. Click on point locations for individual permit details.



Legend

The Legend widget will change based on the layers selected from the Layer List widget.



Projects Around You

Click the Projects Around You icon to find projects within a specified mile radius from a chosen location. Just type the address in the "Search for a location" and then choose the size of the radius around that location by defining your buffer as desired. You can also download a list of permits within that defined area using this widget.
