***Neighborhood History:***

Godley Station is on the far west side of Chatham County, bounded by Saint Augustine's Creek on the north and east, Interstate 95 on the west, and portions of Benton Boulevard to the south. The neighborhood is adjacent to the Savannah International Airport, the Crossroads Business Center and the cities of Port Wentworth and Pooler.

The Godley Tract was annexed into the City of Savannah in 1996. The community was named after a farming and timber-growing family who in the late 1800s supplied ice to trains going north and south across their property. Most of Godley Station is in Pooler, the northern portion is in Savannah, and a small portion is in Port Wentworth. Several tracts of the community are protected wetlands. Godley Station School services children of the area offering kindergarten through eighth grade.

***Scope and Content:***

The Godley Station Community Collection contains prompt cards from area residents with reflections on the Godley Station neighborhood. The written reflections were collected at the 2022 Public Art Dedication for Jerome B. Meadows' installation "Of Communities and the Land and the Trees that Bear Witness to them," at the EnMarket Arena. These items were collected as a part of the Savannah Community Memory Project.
