


MADISON SQUARE

Perhaps the most distinctive feature of Savannah is its 21 squares. Originally designed for fairs and as places of refuge in times of crisis, they have become manicured settings for giant oak and magnolia trees, monuments and fountains. Madison Square was created in 1814 and honors U.S. President James Madison. The area was the site of the British victory over American patriots in 1778 but the focal point of the square is Alexander Doyle's statue of patriot Sergeant William Jasper whose heroics in the Battle of Fort Moultrie in 1776 at Charleston had made him a legend in South Carolina. He was killed at the second Battle of Savannah in 1779. The statue was unveiled in 1888 and is one of the few monuments to a common soldier of the American Revolution.

JASPER MONUMENT-MADISON SQUARE.
In Madison Square stands the monument erected to the memory of Sergeant Wm. Jasper, the hero who fell in the siege of Savannah in 1779. The corner stone was laid October 9th, 1879, and the monument was unveiled February 22d, 1888. Jasper's heroic rescue of the American flag, when the staff was shot down by the British, was the most notable act of his life.
