

This course is appropriate only for students with little or no prior experience, students may not repeat the course.

Completed projects will be glazed and fired, allowing participants to end the course with fully finished pieces. Students are welcome to attend Clay Open Studio hours, included with registration.

Important information for students: This class is designed for students who have developed solid foundational skills in throwing and centering before taking this class. This class is not appropriate for students who still need guidance in these areas. Students are expected to follow the instructor's curriculum.

### **Handmade Metal Beads and Accents**

Class Description: Design and fabricate your own custom metal beads and accents in this hands-on class focused on expanding your jewelry-making skills. Students will form beads from sheet and wire, create functional findings like bead caps and spacers to secure other beads in their work, and refine clean, controlled soldering techniques. We'll also explore attaching wire details, decorative balls, and small soldered components to add texture, dimension, and distinctive character to your designs.

Copper, Brass, equipment, and tools are provided for all class projects. If you would like to work in silver, you can purchase materials from sources like RioGrande.com or Ex Libris on MLK. Participants are welcome to attend Jewelry Open Studio, included with registration.

Class Description: Ready to move beyond the basics? This class is designed for continuing metalsmiths who want to build confidence in experimenting, problem-solving, and creating jewelry that reflects their personal style.

In this session, we'll transform simple wire into dynamic cuff, ring, and earring designs—learning how to bend, shape, and structure it into forms that go far beyond the ordinary. We'll also work with sheet metal, exploring forming and finishing techniques such as planishing, repoussé, and patinas to add color, dimension, texture, and subtle low-relief motifs that bring depth and personality to your pieces.

Copper, Brass, equipment, and tools are provided for all class projects. If you would like to work in silver, you can purchase materials from sources like RioGrande.com or Ex Libris on MLK. Participants are welcome to attend Jewelry Open Studio, included with registration.


